THE LAST SUPPER

Matthew 26: 17 -19,
Mark 14: 12 - 26



Jesus ate the Last Supper with His disciples and served them. Before that, Jesus washed the disciples' feet, teaching them to be humble and to serve one another. He spent the last night of His mortal life observing the Passover. He also instituted the Communion, invited them to eat the bread and drink the wine. In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus' disciples fell asleep while He went to pray. He began the atoning sacrifice where he took upon our sins, infirmities, and sorrows. He suffered a lot until he bled from every pore.

Mark 15: 34

A crown of thorns was placed upon His head, and He carried His cross to Golgatha, where He was crucified.
